Our Congregational Prayer Ministry Coordinator shall work under the oversight of our Pastor and serve our efforts by connecting the Prayer requests received with the various boards, groups or individuals. The purpose of this is to better serve our members, visitors and the community at large. The boards, groups and individuals who are approached in this regard, are free to follows up as they deem most advisable.

Our Congregational Prayer Ministry Coordinator will follow up with whomever agrees to provide care to those indicated in the Prayer request. The purpose of this follow up is to gather information so that the church leadership can be better aware of and communicate more clearly regarding how our church follows up with the prayer requests received.

Our Congregational Prayer Ministry Coordinator will be encouraged to provide a summary report of our ministry of connecting Prayer requests to Mercy Ministry on a regular basis. This report will note Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats to the Prayer Ministry of our church. This report will be made available to all leaders in our congregation.

Our Congregational Prayer Ministry Coordinator will be authorized to recruit and train helpers as our Pastor feels will be most helpful. This training will be done under the supervision of our Pastor.

All of our Prayer Ministry will follow our practices and policies regarding confidentiality, Christian discipline, statements of beliefs and our congregation's mission and ministry plan.

Our Congregational Prayer Ministry will be supported in our annual budget, all gifts and expenditures will follow our approved congregational process. Members will be encouraged to support this ministry with their prayers and additional gifts as God allows.
